**1 Million dogs & cats enter California shelters
each year and 500,000 are put to death.**

Cost to California Taxpayers: \$250 Million per year.

Please spay or neuter your pet!

DID YOU KNOW?

- One female dog and her offspring can produce 67,000 pups in six years.
- One female cat and her offspring can produce 420,000 kittens in seven years.
- A mother cat with 2 week old kittens can become pregnant again. Thousands of kittens are killed in local shelters each year.
- Spaying or neutering can diminish many behavior problems.
- Altered pets are less likely to bite.
- Neutered cats are less likely to spray.
- Altered pets live longer, healthier lives and are less likely to develop cancer.
- It is not true that pets should have one litter or that altered pets become fat and lazy.
- Even if you find good homes for your pups or kittens, you have taken a good home away from a pet in a shelter.
- At least one out of four pets in shelters is a purebred.
- California state law provides that all altered dogs are entitled to a license at a discount.

- **SPAY & NEUTER ASSISTANCE** through financial assistance and referrals to veterinarians who will perform spay/neuter surgery at low cost.
- **HUMANE CARE CENTER & NO KILL KENNEL** licensed to provide care for over 100 dogs and cats from shelters, streets, and hardship situations, while awaiting adoption to approved homes. **Call (714) 893-4393 or visit www.aaloc.org**
- **PET AID** financial assistance to low-income, elderly and disabled pet owners who need help with transportation, emergency veterinary fees and routine care.
- **SHELTER AID** financial assistance for veterinary care of special needs animals from local animal shelters who suffer from illness, injury, neglect, or abuse and need rescue and rehabilitation.
- **HUMANE EDUCATION** through speaking engagements and the distribution of educational materials throughout Orange County.
- **PET PLANNING** to assist pet owners with placement arrangements for their beloved pets in the event of the owner's death or disability.

KEEP YOUR PET SAFE

- Keep current license and ID tags with 2 or more telephone numbers on pets and have pets microchipped. Choke collars are not safe for unsupervised wear. Cats should wear "breakaway collars."
- Do not leave pets alone in cars or at storefronts. Many are stolen and sold to research labs by "bunchers", or used for food for exotic snakes, or for bait to train fighting dogs. Do not run "free to good home" ads in newspapers.
- Pets drown in unfenced swimming pools.
- Coyotes inhabit all cities in Orange County, hunt both day & night, and can get over 8 foot fencing.
- Slug/snail bait, cocoa mulch, fertilizers, and many common plants are toxic and deadly to pets.
- Keep a lock on your gates at all times.
- Do not forget your pet in your family's disaster plan. Evacuation centers often require carriers.
- Flea/tick treatments for dogs can kill cats. Many are also unsafe for very small, young, or ill animals. Avoid those containing pyrethrins, pyrethroids, organophosphates, and carbamates. Consult your Vet for safe flea/tick treatments.
- Keep pets inside during fireworks and thunder. Many escape yards when frightened.
- Bring pets inside on hot days. Heat stroke comes quickly and is very deadly.
